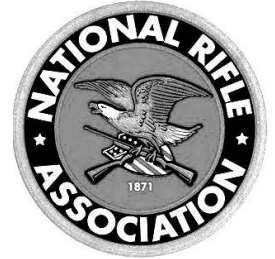

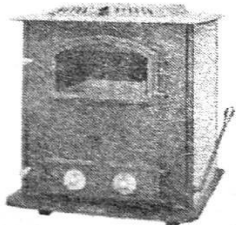

NEW - NEW - NEW - NEW 22 Caliber Rifles Trial Basis For PA STEEL

Rules for Rifles will be:

1. - **Must have a removable magazine.**
2. - **No tube fed rifles may be used.**
(NO TUBE FED RIFLES
ONLY APPLIES TO PA STEEL)
3. - **Bolt action, semi-auto, pump or
break-open rifles may be used.**
4. - **22 caliber long rifle only.**
5. - **Any sight system is okay except laser
sights.**
6. - **Rifles must be kept cased until on firing line.**
7. - **All the rules for handguns will also apply to
rifles.**
8. - **All PA Steel range rules will apply.**

CLARIFICATION ON .22 RIFLES

There has been an extremely large amount of con-
fusion concerning the last newsletter which had a
mention about tube fed rifles .

That prompted an extremely large volume of phone
calls and e-mails to me.

You may use any type .22 rifle while you are on
SLCFSA ranges, including magnums and tube fed ri-
fles.

However, you may only use .22 rifles that have a
removable magazine and they must be .22LR **ONLY!**
No magnums - no tube fed rifles -no birdshot -if you
plan on shooting.... PA STEEL ONLY.

PA STEEL RECAP

The Pa Steel shooting season is over for the 2011 season , and we had an absolutely fantastic, safe and successful season. We had a total of 11 shoots , Feb thru Dec , shooting in the snow Feb and Mar and have a growing contingent of lady and junior shooters. We had a record number of shooters at our last shoot of the season , which was a free, shooter appreciation shoot , Dec 17th , with a total 51 shooters throughout the day - WOW !!!!! Three years ago, when we started the Pa Steel shoots , we started with only 5 shooters and enough targets and stands for 2 stages and had to stop and change setups every round. Today, we have five full stages on 5 different ranges with all the stands and targets necessary to variate target placement to make shooting Pa Steel, challenging , interesting and , just plain fun !

Three years ago, we started a .22 LR class for Junior shooters age 16 and under; and it was a big hit (pun intended) , so last year we decided to open .22 LR up to everyone , and it was an immediate hit, so this year we decided to try a .22Lr rifle class , and boy, that was a REALLY big hit !

We have everything from 9mm thru 45 ACP , in revolvers and semi-auto's , but it seems that .22LR has become the most dominant cartridge followed by 9MM. Roughly half our shooters now use .22LR rifles at various times throughout the year. A lot of our shooters have built guns from the ground up just for shooting Pa Steel: both hand guns and rifles . We certainly have an extremely interesting array of " fancied-up " guns with some rather unique sight systems among our cadre of shooters . Some of our shooters shoot in the Pa Steel League as well .

I'd like to share a few tidbits of interesting facts with everyone . Three years ago , when we first started , we had 5 shooters at our first shoot and had a total of 6 shoots and 56 shooters for the year. We had only 2 stages (10 targets and stands) and the cost was \$5.00 to shoot.

Last year we had 10 shoots with a total of 176 shooters for the year with 5 full stages of 25 targets and stands . Cost went to \$10.00 This year we had 11 shoots with a total of 296 shooters and the cost stayed at \$10.00 The club gained 4 new members from our shoots the first year , 11 last year and 17 this year .

Our first year we generated \$205.00 for the club and the club spent more on us than we gave back . Last year we generated \$1490.00 and the club again spent more on us than we gave back . This year was different as we generated approx. \$2680.00 for the club and about \$2000.00 of that was above what the club spent on us. The first year the club allocated \$500.00 for 10 targets and stands for us to get started. Last year the club allocated the \$1400.00 to build the other 15 targets and stands. This year the only cost was for paint and a few small items here and there. Three years ago we averaged 9 shooters per shoot. Last year it was 17 and this year it was 30 shooters per shoot. Our last 4 or 5 shoots we had an average of 45 shooters at each shoot .

We have been drawing shooters from not only Pa, but as far away as Va , NY, Md, Del. Unless you go out to the mid west , there's no place that does what we do here at SLCFSA and New Holland Rifle and Pistol Club (Jeff, Joey and I also run the Pa Steel shoots there as well) unless you shoot in the Pa Steel League . SLCFSA and NHRPC conducts our Pa Steel shoots in conjunction with each other and we are listed on each others events calendar ,all the links are on both clubs website and you can access either club from either club home page.

We have a total of 9 NRA certified Range Safety Officers , 5 NRA certified Firearms Instructors and by the time you read this newsletter , we will also have a Lady NRA certified Firearms instructor and Range Safety Officer. All our shoots are ran with an NRA certified Range Safety Officer in charge of each squad.

All the SLCFSA range rules and policies apply to our shoots and we have our own rules that are extremely strict and specific, with no exceptions, that begin as soon as you enter the driveway leading up the hill to our shoots . SAFETY IS FIRST AND FOREMOST. We shoot rain, snow or shine so next year we will also have canopies to keep us and the electronic timers and score sheets dry and shade from the scorching sun.

Come out and try this very exciting and enjoyable sport . If you don't have the equipment we will loan you a gun to try . We especially target the ladies and junior shooters. We definately need more ladies in the shooting sports at all levels.


